1. KAU TAPEN LODGE

WHERE IT ALL STARTED

Founded in 1984, Kau Tapen was the first lodge on the Río Grande—the birthplace of sea-run brown trout fishing and the benchmark for all that followed. Its name, in the Ona language, means “House of Fishing,” a fitting tribute to a river that produces the largest sea-runs on Earth.

With exclusive access to 25 km of the middle Río Grande and 25 km of its most productive tributary, the Menéndez, anglers enjoy exceptional variety and water management that ensures new beats every day. The rivers’ size and flow make them perfect for single, switch, and double-handed rods, from swinging streamers through classic tail-outs to presenting delicate flies on intimate channels.

Five IGFA world records have been set here, and each season adds new stories to its legend. Kau Tapen remains the ultimate blend of heritage, comfort, and the finest sea-run brown trout fishing on the planet.

Villa María was the second of the De Las Carreras family lodges to open on the Río Grande after Kau Tapen and has offered small, private groups exciting fishing on some of the most productive pools in the lower river since 1994.

Unlike Kau Tapen, which is located on the middle river, Villa María offers anglers first crack at newly arrived Sea Trout on the lower Río Grande. For fishermen who enjoy the challenges and rewards of two-handed rods, this is a dream come true! With friendly and dedicated house staff and guides, Villa María is very well suited to caring for small groups of friends and family.

IN THE SEARCH OF GOLD

Golden dorado thrive in the Iberá Marshlands, and Pirá Lodge places you at the heart of this exceptional fishery. Clear water, healthy structure, and constant movement make Iberá a rare place where sight-casting, hunting banks, and explosive takes all come together.

Since 1999, Pirá has led the way as the first lodge built exclusively for dorado on the fly. It remains the only destination where anglers fish from Hell's Bay skiffs, poling shallow channels, grass flats, and lagoons much like a saltwater fishery. When conditions allow, wading adds another dimension to the experience.

From winding marsh creeks to the fast Headwaters and the broad Corriente River, each environment fishes differently. Streamers, mice, skaters, floating or sinking lines—every day brings new water and fresh opportunities.

Back at the lodge, comfort and design meet a strong sense of place. Purpose-built for dorado anglers, Pirá offers top-tier accommodations, refined cuisine, seamless service, curated gear, and guides who know Iberá inside out—all set within a landscape alive with wildlife and constant movement.

This area holds one of the most productive sections on the entire system—a clear-water fishery shaped by fast currents and expansive rock gardens, where large dorado thrive.

Our intimate jungle lodge serves as a warm and comfortable base for anglers in search of these powerful fish. Whether crashing sábalo on shallow sand flats or sliding along jungle-lined banks, the dorado of Suindá are smart, selective, moody, and incredibly rewarding—offering one of the most technical freshwater experiences in South America.

Imagine fishing for golden dorado less than an hour from downtown Buenos Aires. Delta Lodge offers a unique experience among the quiet islands and winding channels of the Paraná Delta—ideal for anglers and travelers short on time.

Set deep within this lush landscape, the lodge delivers the fishing, guiding, lodging, and cuisine that define the Nervous Waters experience. The fishery is productive, visual, and varied, targeting golden dorado, tararira, and other native species with fly, spinning, or conventional tackle.

We offer two ways to experience it:

DAY TRIPS: Perfect for guests spending a night or two in Buenos Aires or adding a day on the water to a business trip. A private transfer picks you up at your hotel, and within 40 minutes you’re on a skiff, ready to fish.

LODGE STAY: For a more immersive visit, stay on our secluded island lodge. One or two nights allow for relaxed fishing, great meals, and a deeper connection to this unique ecosystem.

IN THE CHASE OF MIGRATION

Karandá brings together Argentina's most renowned outfitter, Nervous Waters, and some of the world's finest Golden Dorado guides. Set along the middle section of the Río Paraná—South America's second-longest river and watershed—this subtropical winter and spring fishery, running from June through December, coincides with the peak of the river's legendary Dorado migration.

Each year, the arrival of vast schools of sábalo brings the season to life. Aggressive Dorado feed heavily on the baitfish, reaching impressive sizes of 10 to 25+ pounds. After five full years of scouting and exploration, our guides have developed a deep understanding of the habits, holding water, and seasonal movements of these powerful and complex fish.

Golden Dorado are the primary target species. Guests can sight-fish to Dorado cruising long sandbars, explore remote backwater creeks, and work a wide range of productive water—from woody structure and cut banks to deep channels and current seams.

ON THE MARLS

Abaco Lodge is the only fly-fishing operation located directly on the famed Marls, a vast labyrinth of shallow flats, mangrove cays, and bonefish in numbers found nowhere else in the Bahamas.

Days of fifteen to twenty bonefish are not uncommon across this expansive fishery, where more than 300 square miles of pristine habitat stretch across the western side of Great Abaco Island. With the lodge positioned directly on the Marls, there is no trailering and no fuel stops—just more time fishing.

Simply step away from the breakfast table and walk down to the dock, where our fleet of Maverick flats skiffs and some of the island's most knowledgeable guides await. Within minutes, anglers are gliding across clear water in search of cruising bonefish.

Back at the lodge, private guest rooms, excellent cuisine, and attentive service provide the perfect setting to relax after a full day on the flats.

Abaco Lodge is also one of the most conveniently located bonefishing destinations in the Caribbean. Direct flights from Florida make travel simple and efficient, with easy access through Marsh Harbour Airport, located just a short transfer from the lodge.

With privileged access to some of the most lightly pressured flats in the region, anglers experience one of the healthiest and most consistent permit fisheries anywhere, alongside excellent consistent opportunities for tarpon, bonefish, and snook—the core ingredients of countless Grand Slams.

The lodge pairs its authentic Caribbean feel with elevated comfort: refurbished rooms, solar-powered systems, an expanded dining and lounge area, and à la carte cuisine crafted to Nervous Waters standards. From sunrise casts across glass-clear flats to evenings under the palapa bar, ESB remains the soul of Espíritu Santo's flats—wild, refined, and unmatched for permit.

Located on the pristine shores of Mexico's Sian Ka'an Reserve, Beh Kay Lodge offers a fresh and simple take on the Caribbean saltwater experience. Set on a stretch of beach that remains naturally free of sargassum thanks to local currents, the lodge provides direct access to one of the world's most celebrated permit fisheries—where crystal-clear flats stretch endlessly under the tropical sun.

Designed for a select group of just eight anglers, Beh Kay features four spacious geodesic domes—each shared by two guests—making it the first fly-fishing lodge in the Caribbean built around this innovative concept. The domes blend comfort with a close connection to nature, featuring ocean views and essential amenities. The main lodge includes an open bar, fly shop, and fly-tying area.

Guests enjoy à la carte dining, relaxed service, and a guiding program rooted in teamwork and local knowledge. Here, precision meets simplicity—exceptional fishing, barefoot comfort, and the quiet rhythm of the Yucatán coast.

There is no better location on the legendary Madison River than the Madison River Lodge. The program is conveniently located at the heart of the famed “50 mile riffle” placing anglers at the center of some of the most productive wild trout water in Montana. After a great day on the water guests can expect to return to a full service all-inclusvie lodge with exceptional meals and a relaxed atmosphere. The lodge schedule revolves around conditions and the guest experience. With over 5,000 trout per mile right off the decks, there is no shortage of productive water within minutes of the lodge. Anglers can also explore other productive waters in the region including fisheries within Yellowstone Park and several other rivers within an hour of the lodge. The Madison is an incredibly consistent fishery over most periods of our fishing season. Everything is included in this package so you just show up, eat, fish and relax and let us take care of the rest!

ABOVE THE RIVER, IN THE GAME

The Missouri Cliffs Lodge is perched atop a towering cliff with sweeping views of the Missouri River. The lodge is centrally located in the canyon section of the Missouri River tailwater. The Missouri is known for high trout counts, large average size fish, and consistent water temperatures due to the chain of lakes and dams upstream. The Missouri is famous for its productive waters and heavy aquatic insect hatches that commonly produce large pods of surface feeding trout. After a day on the water, return to the lodge to enjoy hors d'oeuvres and libations in the barnwood wrapped saloon or a cocktail on the wrap around decks overlooking the river. Enjoy multi-course meals each evening in the window wrapped dining room . The lodge has 6 comfortable guest rooms, each with 2 beds and an en suite bathroom.

17. BOULDER RIVER OUTPOST

WHERE MONTANA STILL FEELS WILD

The Outpost offers anglers one of the most diverse fishing experiences in Montana. With access to multiple float and wade rivers, spring creeks and private ranch stillwaters, guests can expect to sample a rich assortment of unique fisheries. This is a fully all-inclusive program, including guiding, equipment, all meals, and beverages. Accommodations are in two rustic yet very comfortable cabins set directly along the East Boulder River, just a few hundred yards from the main Boulder. The setting is exceptionally private, surrounded by mature cottonwoods, spruce, and willows, with sweeping views across a large ranch toward the mountains beyond. Mornings might begin with a float on the Boulder just down the road, or a drive to remote private waters near the Crazy Mountains, offering a different experience each day depending on conditions and angler preference. The intimate nature of the Outpost also makes it ideal as an exclusive venue for smaller groups.



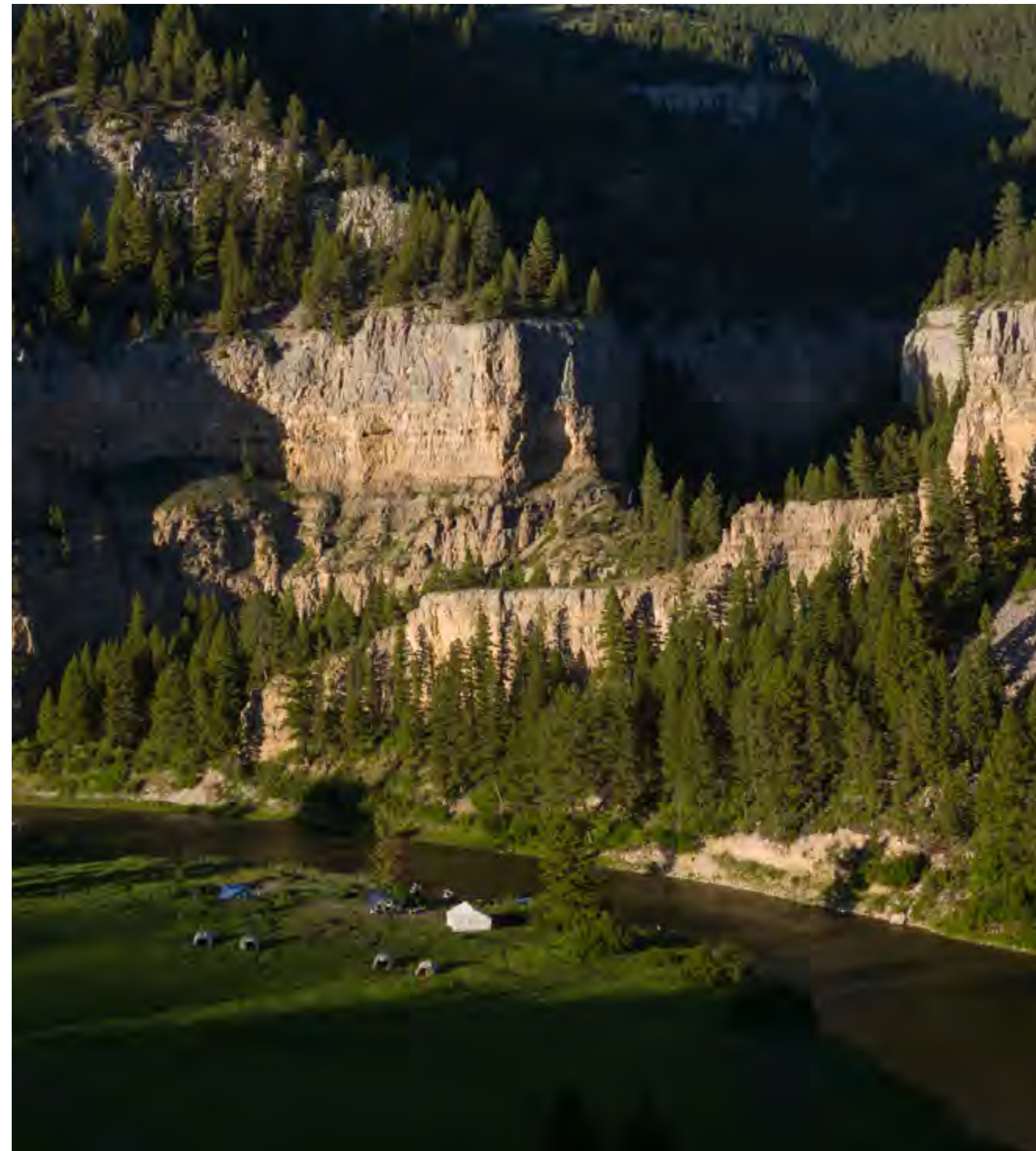
18. SMITH RIVER OVERNIGHT TRIPS

MONTANA'S MOST COVETED FLOAT

The Smith River is widely considered to be the best multi-day fly fishing river in the lower 48. The majority of the float is through a spectacular limestone canyon. Dense evergreen forests are also common and you camp at four remote campsites along the way. The fishing is very good and the scenery and wildlife viewing are even better. This is a very highly sought after trip and also strictly permitted. Camps are limited to 8 anglers. For smaller groups we mix parties on the same trip (again, a max of 8). These are first class trips all the way with multiple guides running camp and a 2:1 ratio of angler to guide while fishing.
